NOTE: Petitions for Mayor or City Commissioners must be signed in ink by a minimum of two hundred fifty electors or a maximum of five hundred electors. Each elector signing a petition shall add to his signature his place of residence, with street and number, and date of signing. Petitions must be filed not less than ninety days before the date of the Primary Election. No signatures thereto may be secured more than one hundred ten days prior to the date of such Primary Election. The signatures need not all be on one paper, but each separate paper must be sworn to. Each candidate must file a written acceptance of his candidacy not later than fifty-five days before the date of such Primary Election.
